- Registered for full-time students.

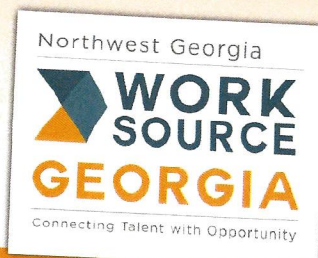
Also must meet at least one criteria in the areas of either Adult Funding or Dislocated Worker Funding.

WIOA, also known as Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, is a federal grant program that helps low-income individuals or dislocated workers with receiving an education or training. WIOA will pay for books, tuition and fees for a qualified participant. We also will give gas money for everyday a person is going to training or class. To qualify you must be 18 years or older, low-income, on public assistance, or a dislocated worker and must enroll or be enrolled in a qualified program
